Council members met with Bill Fisher from the Crawford Parks District, Cynthia Brookes from the Sandusky River Watershed and Diane Sand, representative from the Soil and Water District of Crawford County.

Many questions were answered by Mrs. Brookes:

3. Who can be involved?
4. Who has liability? (sample of waiver attached)
5. What would the city be responsible for?
6. Time frame? (when should this happen)

She also talked to us about *Coastweeks* which is an expression of individual's commitment to clean and save beaches and waterways.

I had a short meeting with SSD Sid SeEVERS and he said the city would supply an outlet for the trash picked up and possibly the use of a loader but wouldn't commit any city workers for this project.

We hope to get others involved like the hospital for sharps containers and maybe TSC for donations of bags and gloves. This will also include any other group willing to help in this effort.
